MedBAN, the Mediterranean Blue Acceleration Network, is mobilizing EU blue economy SMEs to adopt processes and technologies for a greener, more digital and resilient economy. MedBAN integrates the Euroclusters' Initiative and is closely aligned with its specific objectives on the adoption of processes and technologies for the green and digital transition, training for the up and re-skilling of the workforce and internationalization of EU SMEs.

MedBAN has analyzed the EU Mediterranean countries' blue economy ecosystem to understand its inner workings, key players, barriers, and opportunities. This resulted in a resilience preparedness/continuity plan highlighting new collaboration models. The identified challenges drive the SME-focused open calls and the cluster training, enhancing a resilient and innovative Blue Economy in the Single Market.

A total of **88 SMEs** from **14 countries** have participated in these calls, collectively submitting **100 applications**. These applications are centred around adapting processes and technologies to create a greener, more digital, and resilient blue economy.
